Student Code of Conduct & Responsibilities

In alignment with ADEK Policy, our school is committed to fostering a safe, respectful, and inclusive learning environment. Students are expected to adhere to the following standards of behaviour:

- Respect for Others: Students must demonstrate respect and courtesy towards peers, staff, and the community. Bullying, harassment, and discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Academic Integrity: Honesty and integrity are paramount. Students must not engage in cheating, plagiarism, or any form of academic dishonesty.
- Attendance and Punctuality: Regular attendance and timely arrival to school and classes are essential. Absences must be justified with valid reasons and documentation. Minimum attendance 98%
- Behaviour and Discipline: Students are expected to follow school rules and instructions from staff. Disruptive behaviour, vandalism, and acts of violence are strictly prohibited.
- Digital Citizenship: Responsible use of technology is mandatory. Students must use school digital resources ethically and avoid inappropriate content or cyberbullying.
- Dress Code: Adherence to the school's dress code is required at all times to promote a focused and respectful learning environment.
- Health and Safety: Students must adhere to all health and safety guidelines, including those related to hygiene and physical distancing when necessary.
- Out of Bounds: Certain areas of the school are designated as out of bounds for students unless they are accompanied by a staff member or have obtained special permission:
 - o Lifts (unless a medical pass has been authorized)
 - o All Science Labs, ICT, Art, and Music Rooms
- Corridor Etiquette: We emphasize courteous behaviour among our students throughout the school. Students are encouraged to greet all adults respectfully. Walking, rather than running, is always expected to maintain our corridor etiquette.

Parental Code of Conduct & Responsibilities

In accordance with ADEK policy, we expect all parents to contribute to a positive and respectful school environment. This Parental Code of Conduct outlines the standards and behaviours expected to support our educational community.

- Respect and Courtesy: Treat all school staff, students and fellow parents with respect and courtesy. Avoid confrontational or aggressive behaviour, including verbal or physical abuse.
- · Communication: Engage in open, respectful communication with teachers and









school staff. Address concerns through appropriate channels and maintain confidentiality regarding school matters.

- Support: Actively support your child's education by ensuring regular attendance (minimum 98% attendance), punctuality and preparedness for school. Attend school meetings, events and parent-teacher meetings.
- Safety and Well-being: Follow school policies and procedures regarding safety, including adhering to drop-off and pick-up protocols. Promote a healthy lifestyle and monitor your child's use of technology and social media.
- Cooperation: Work collaboratively with the school to resolve issues or concerns.
 Refrain from making unfounded complaints or spreading misinformation that could harm the school community.
- Financial Responsibility: Pay fees on time and re-enroll my child/children before the final deadline to avoid loss of place; pay for lost or damaged books/resources
